WHO

We are seeking both medical professionals to serve in the on-site medical clinic, and/or adults willing to perform light construction work and engage with children. Youth are welcome but must be accompanied by an adult family member.

WHAT

Eagle's Nest International/Nido Del Aguila Children's Home and Retreat Center exists to show the love of Christ to the abandoned children of Guatemala. Nido Del Aguila is an association made up of pastors and missionaries providing physical, emotional, mental, and spiritual care to abandoned, abused, and neglected children. WHERE

The Children's Home is located on a large property in the mountains of Sololá, Guatemala, and includes accommodations for the team. The team will fly into Guatemala City and then travel by bus to the Children's Home.

HOW

The medical team members will assist with screenings for the children on site, organize and compile previous medical records and files, and collaborate with staff for treatment plans. Other team members will assist with light construction/painting and cleaning projects. All team members will work collaboratively with staff missionaries to meet needs that may arise during the week, both on campus and in the nearby community. The team will also participate in evening sessions for worship, prayer, discussion, and planning.
