WHERE

About an hour from Montreal, Quebec, Camp Livingstone sits on 71 acres of land surrounding Lake Lovering, including 22 buildings, a mountainside & nature trails. Less than 1% of the population of Quebec considers themselves Evangelical, having 1 French Evangelical church for every 100,000 people. Quebec is primarily a French-speaking population, where only 8% of the population considers English their Mother tongue, and only 11% speak English most of the time at home. The people of Quebec value their culture, their language, and their independence.

HOW

There is much ground and facility preparation that needs to get done before Camp Livingstone receives its campers each season, and this team will be assisting for the week to help tackle this big job. Team members will perform a variety of tasks, including but not limited to, painting, minor repairs, setting up archery and ax throwing stations, cleaning the kitchen and bathrooms, cleaning the trails, raking, cleaning out the garden beds, and planting new flowers. Team members will also have the opportunity to lead a local church's youth service on Thursday night (games, a short message, and small group discussion).
