DAILY PRAYER PROMPTS

MONDAY

Pray for the Broadmoor Church family

(Matthew 9:38)

- Pray for the Lord to stir in our church family conviction and urgency to join together in prayer for a spiritual harvest this week and in the weeks to come.
- Pray the Church staff as they lead and encourage the Broadmoor family to be a church that incorporates prayer as a key component of our overall mission to make disciples.

TUESDAY

Prayer for our Families

- Pray for opportunities for your family to encourage each other through gospel conversations.
- Pray for members of the family to have opportunities for gospel conversations with their neighbors.

WEDNESDAY

Pray for Christian brothers and sisters who serve in our Local, State, and National Government

- Pray for the believers in these roles to remain steadfast and to be guided by their faith in Jesus.
- Pray for a specific Christian government official today. Ask for the Lord to use that individual to draw others to Him and that these servants would have opportunities for gospel conversations.

THURSDAY

Prayer for our Neighbors

- Pray for the believers in your neighborhood. Ask the Lord to use them to have gospel conversations with other neighbors.
- Pray for specific individuals in your neighborhood that have not yet chosen to follow Jesus. Ask the Lord to give you an opportunity to have a gospel conversation with those individuals.

FRIDAY

Prayer for our Co-workers/Classmates

- Pray for the believers at your workplace or at your school. Ask the Lord to use them to have gospel conversations with other classmates or co-workers.
- Pray for specific individuals in your school/workplace that have not yet chosen to follow Jesus. Ask the Lord to give you an opportunity to have a gospel conversation with those individuals.
